

Explore Cornwall by train

Cornwall is served by the Penzance to London Paddington main line and five scenic branch lines. The main line runs through Cornwall to the Devon border at Saltash, where it crosses the River Tamar, heading on to Plymouth and beyond. Direct destinations outside Cornwall include: Exeter, Taunton, Bristol, Birmingham and the Midlands, Manchester and the North of England, Reading for the Thames Valley, and London.

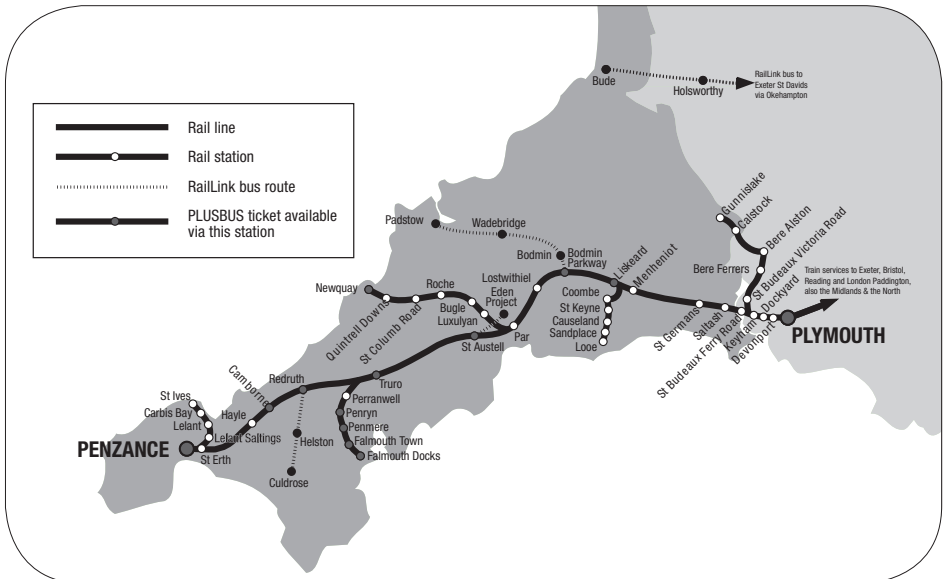

Great value fares & tickets

Devon & Cornwall Railcard

For an annual fee of just £10, the Devon & Cornwall Railcard gives you a 33% discount on off-peak standard train fares in Cornwall. You can buy the Railcard from staffed stations in Cornwall and Plymouth, or at National Rail Travel Agents in Cornwall and Plymouth. The Railcard is only available to residents (over the age of 16) of Cornwall, Devon, the Isles of Scilly and Plymouth City (PL postal code area). Ride Cornwall

Enjoy unlimited travel for one day on all rail and most bus services within Cornwall and between Cornwall and Plymouth, after 09:00 Monday–Friday and at any time on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

An adult ticket cost £10.00 and can be used on First Great Western and CrossCountry train services, as well as on First Devon & Cornwall and Western Greyhound bus services. Railcard discounts are available. For bus times, visit:

PLUSBUS



Add unlimited bus travel around town to your train ticket for a small additional fee of around £2 a day. The bus travel can be at the start of your journey, the end, or both. PLUSBUS is available in: Bodmin, Camborne, Falmouth, Liskeard, Newquay, Penryn, Penzance, Plymouth, Redruth, St Austell and Truro. Simply ask for a PLUSBUS ticket when buying your train ticket. Cycles and trains

All train companies in Cornwall can carry bicycles, but only on certain types of train. You should always check with the train operator before travelling. A 'Cycling by train' guide is available from any of our staffed train stations. Information is also available online at:

Cycle lockers are currently available at our stations in Truro, Penzance, St Austell, Liskeard and Redruth. The lockers enable a bicycle and related accessories to be stored in a dry and secure environment. They are available to rent for three, six or 12 month periods. You'll be able to access your locker even when the station is unstaffed. For more information ask at the station ticket office.
